





#### WHY VISIT LAKE LOUISE?

Renowned as the birthplace of mountaineering in Canada, Lake Louise is an authentic alpine town in the heart of Banff National Park. With 4200 skiable acres, Lake Louise is one of the largest ski resorts in North America.

The unique layout allows families and groups of varying abilities to ski together with beginner, intermediate and expert runs from every chair. Beginners and intermediate skiers have access to an abundance of gentle slopes and long cruising runs. Experts can explore endless chutes, glades, gullies and remote bowls in some of the Rockies' most challenging terrain. More terrain than you can ski in a week, that's for sure. Lake Louise also offers dog sledding, cross country skiing, ice skating, and horse drawn sleigh rides.

#### WHY VISIT SUNSHINE VILLAGE?

Sunshine Village sits high on the Continental Divide in the heart of Banff National Park just 15 minutes' drive from the cozy mountain town of Banff. The first lift takes you up 5 miles to the base area (17 minutes). Three sprawling mountains (Goat's Eye, Standish, Lookout) provide breathtaking site lines, uninterrupted by any signs of civilization beyond the resort's leasehold.

Sunshine Village's seven-month season stretches from early November until late May – the longest non-glacial ski season in Canada. Sunshine can receive up to 9 metres (30 feet) of snow in a season and the Village's altitude of 2195 meters (7,200 feet) ensures the snow stays light and dry.

The world-renowned resort features more than 3,300 acres of skiable terrain, ranging from gentle beginner runs all the way up to extreme big mountain runs. Sunshine's very own Delirium Dive has been named one of the 10 top off-piste destinations in the world.



#### WHY VISIT MT. NORQUAY?

Since its opening in 1926, Mt. Norquay continues to be the local gem. Famous for being the training ground of Olympic and World Cup athletes, and with excellent beginner terrain, everyone will love this small, family–friendly resort. Just minutes from the Town of Banff, Mt. Norquay offers the only night skiing in Banff–Lake Louise, including a fully lit terrain park, and expert snowmaking on 85% of the terrain. 



#### WHY VISIT WHITEWATER?

Sitting within the Powder Triangle of British Columbia, Whitewater Ski Resort (aka WH20) sits within the Selkirk Mountains, an area renowned for plentiful dry snow. It was a tiny little thing prior to 2010 but with the addition of the Glory Ridge triple chair the terrain has doubled and the vertical increased to 623 m (2044 ft). Life is unhurried in Nelson, the culture is relaxed yet cosmopolitan, and there are several great Nelson restaurants. Don't forget to visit the amazing limestone caves at the Ainsworth Hot Springs overlooking Kootenay Lake about 45 minutes' drive from Nelson.







Niseko is comprised of three different ski areas, – Grand Hirafu, Higashiyama & Annapuri. They are all linked together and you can buy the lifts according to where you will ski. While the off-piste and out-of-bounds powder skiing is legendary, the on-piste blues and greens should not be dismissed—every type of skier and rider can enjoy the Niseko experience. Chances are likely that it will snow throughout the duration of your trip but the gondolas

and hooded chairlifts make the snowy weather very bearable. Experience JAPOW– Powder Japanese style. Full force and pure fun.

#### A few tips:

- Dining options are good and plentiful. For a true sushi experience, head to Fuji Sushi in Niseko Hirafu base
- If you want a different adventure, take a guided hike to Mt. Yotei an active volacano, or at least take some photos
- Visit an onsen, a Japanese hot spring and the bathing facilities and inns frequently situated around them
- English is widely spoken, but a few words of Japanese, such as "Konnichiwa" (hello) and "Arigato gozaimasu" (thank you) will always be well received




