THE "SKI" TIES THAT BIND US

Back in 1970, in the early days of Skican, my father, Robin Nasmith, arrived at Whistler to meet with Franz Wilhemsen. Norwegian-born Wilhemsen is famously known as the founder of Whistler Blackcomb and the Garibaldi Lift Company. In those days, the mountain was accessed from Creekside, accommodation was limited, and the Village was a landfill. Robin was hoping to strike a partnership to get more eastern skiers out to experience the BC Rockies.

As the story goes, the meeting was over almost before it got started. For whatever reason, Franz was simply not interested. Later that day, Robin and his long-time friend, Bruce MacDougall, headed to the only restaurant in town. The only other people in the restaurant were Wilhemsen and his wife, Annette. In that intimate, and somewhat awkward setting, the diners got to know each other better and before long Robin and Franz made a discovery.

During World War II, Franz had been based at a Norwegian air force training camp on Oxbow Lake, not far from Huntsville, Ontario. On this very same lake, Robin's grandfather, my great-grandfather, spent the winter in a small log cabin on the only island on the lake. Heinz recalled going for a cross country ski on the lake and seeing the cabin - a trail of smoke betraying its inhabitant. Heinz knocked on the door and, as he told the story, had a great chat with a fellow engineer (my great-grandfather).

This simple connection led to a friendship between Robin and Franz, and opened the door to what would become Skican's most popular resort destination for the next 5 decades.

I love this story because it reflects how I feel about the ski community: It doesn't take much for us to find common ground and develop lifelong relationships built on a mutual passion. And I love picturing the founder of Canada's most iconic ski resort gliding across a frozen lake where 5 generations of Nasmiths have spent countless hours enjoying the stillness of the Canadian Shield. The very same stillness we experience on the ski hill, even while navigating a steep descent.

Kind've makes you want to go for a ski, doesn't it? Have a fantastic year everyone! See you on the slopes.

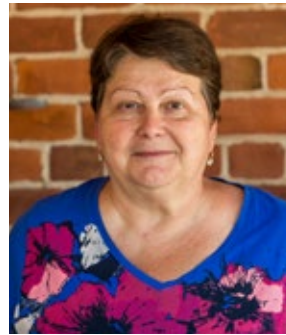

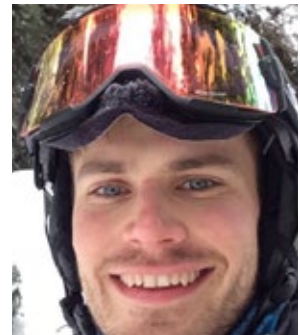

If you're planning your first ski trip, there are a number of things that you should be aware of and prepare for. At Skican, we specialize in building ski vacations for friends, families, solo travelers, or groups. We're here to guide you through the process and deliver the ski vacation that's perfect for you.

IS SKIING WEATHER DEPENDENT?

While it's true that weather does have an impact on your trip, most major ski resorts are located in mountainous areas where there is very consistent snowfall throughout the winter months. Most resorts will also have sophisticated snow-making equipment that allows them to keep the hill open, even if they haven't had a recent snowfall.

If you're an advanced skier, you may wait with baited breath for that huge dump of powder — and wake up early to get first tracks. In this type of situation, the weather may affect your experience, but it's unlikely to prevent you from getting out on the hill.

Weather can impact your ability to reach the resort on time, either by plane, rental car, or shuttle from the airport. Keep an eye on the weather during travel and plan for contingencies should a snowstorm occur.

WILL I BE COLD ON THE SKI HILL?

As you'll soon discover, skiing is a very active sport! You may be a bit cold on the chairlift ride, but once you get moving, you're likely to be hot, and even sweaty.

The best way to prepare for the cold is to bring many different layers of clothing. Layers will allow you to add or remove clothing to stay a comfortable temperature, depending on the day or your current level of activity.

IF I'M NEW TO SKIING HOW CAN I START LEARNING?

If you or someone on your trip is new to skiing, the best way to get started is to take skiing lessons with a professional instructor. It can be difficult to learn to ski with friends or parents, as more advanced skiers will often forget the basic techniques and misjudge what you're capable of doing.

When starting out, it's important to build your confidence gradually. Skiing can be an intimidating sport. If you lose control on the hill and crash, it can take a while to get back to your previous level of comfort. That's why we always recommend lessons for first-time skiers.

HOW WILL I FIND MY WAY AROUND THE SKI RESORT?

When going to a ski resort for the first time, make sure that you get a piste map or trail map. You will typically be given these maps when you pick up your lift tickets.

A piste map is an essential guide to a new resort — even for experienced skiers. Check for trail signs when you get off the top of the lift to help you get started. We also recommend doing some research on your resort ahead of time. Some preparation in advance will help you make the most of your vacation and the exciting adventures to come!

CAN I BOOK A SKI TRIP AT THE LAST MINUTE?

While many people decide to book ski trips at the last minute, we always recommend that you plan your ski trip as far in advance as possible.

Booking early is the best way to get your choice of lodgings, secure early bird deals on lift tickets, and find cheap flights to your destination.

IKON PASS AND EPIC PASS

NOW THAT SKIERS/BOARDERS HAVE TWO INTERESTING MULTI-RESORT PASS OPTIONS BEFORE THEM FOR THE 2018-19 SEASON, THE BIG QUESTION IS, WHICH PASS?

There is a bit of a buzz in the snow travel world. We expect many of you have at least heard the names 'Epic' or 'Ikon' (the new standard for season ski passes), while on the slopes or in the news as of late. The fact is the mountain travel industry is experiencing a bit of disruption, the players running the resorts are getting bigger, and their competitive offerings are getting bigger too. What the outcome could look like for many of us may include improvements in ski facility infrastructure and services for one, and access (often unlimited) to amazing resorts across North America and beyond at a fair price point.

IKON PASS

The IKON Pass covers 30 North American resorts including several high profile resorts like Ski Big 3 (Sunshine Village, Lake Louise and Mt. Norquay), Revelstoke, BC, Aspen Snowmass, CO; Alta and Snowbird, UT; and Jackson Hole, WY and Killington, VT. Sugarloaf and Sunday River, ME; and most recently Niseko Japan.

For skiers in Ontario and Quebec – Blue Mountain and Mont-Tremblant are the winners for frequent weekend warriors, and resorts in Vermont, Maine and New Hampshire are also included. CMH Heli-Ski, BC is another part of this impressive mix. The biggest advantage of this product is that it includes premium destination ski areas, plus great variety closer to home for East Coast customers.

EPIC PASS

The EPIC Pass (Vail Resorts), the popular veteran, provides access to all the Vail resorts including other A-listers like Whistler-Blackcomb, and some mega resorts in Europe, Australia, and Japan.

Recent additions include Telluride and the RCR resorts (Kicking Horse BC, Fernie BC, Kimberley BC and Mont-Ste-Anne). The biggest advantage of this product is its deluxe roster of resorts internationally and therefore its inherent monetary value. Telluride, RCR, European resorts and Japanese resorts all have limited access.

* Both pass options are tiered to accommodate different needs – child, teenager, and adult with basic or premium access. The list of resorts for each pass has not been listed. Please ask Skican for complete details.

WHICH SKI PASS IS RIGHT FOR ME?

Ultimately, the decision to consider/purchase either product will be most easily made by determining where you ski regularly or where your 'home' mountain is – coupled with where you want to ski on vacation.
